What was your first big designer buy?

My first designer buy was the Louis Vuitton Canvas Ellipse Bag. I was in the UK working in media at that point and it was my first exposure to the fashion world. Since I pretty much carry the world with me, it made perfect sense, since I could throw everything in it and run around.

If you had to choose between bags and shoes, which would you pick?

I think that's a ridiculously difficult question. But if you definitely want an answer, I would say, I have a softer corner for shoes. Christian Louboutin, Jimmy Choo and Tod's are my staple wear. I love the Louboutin Red Sole. It is very sexy. And Stuart Weitzman wedges are extremely comfortable for work wear.

Which are the restaurants you just can't get enough of?

I'll name a couple. Sanctum in Bangalore, for its fantastic ambience and the delicious food. My favourite is the beer-infused chicken with cream potatoes. And I always make it a point to have English Lady, which is a delicious cocktail. Coya in London is another favourite. This is a Peruvian restaurant which is contemporary, yet holds on to the traditional style of cooking. It has the best sea bass and monkfish ceviche, the greatest beef skewers and definitely the best aged tequilas.

Tell us about the best bottle of wine you have ever had.

During my last visit to London, my husband and I had a Chūteau Lafite at the Ritz private club which was beautiful and really smooth. Totally indulgent!

What is a must-have item in your bar?

Apart from the lovely Three Royals whiskey from the house of I Brands Beverages, which I have in my bar at all times, I would say the 23-year-old Bruichladdich whiskey is an absolute must-have!

Name an item you possess that holds great sentimental value for you.

After our marriage, my husband gifted me a diamond Rolex watch. It was such a surprise that it became something that is closest to my heart. Plus, the diamond bezel and oyster pearl finish wasn't too hard on the eye!
